SECTION I : READING COMPREHENSION

READ THE TWO TEXTS BELOW AND DO THE RELATED TASKS.

TEXT ONE

[1] All children need attention, but there are some who demand it much more forcefully than others. Both with their peers and parents or carers, they will insist they get their way. They readily *infuriate* other kids by laying down rules that everyone else is supposed to follow. Oblivious of the irritation they cause others, they are quick to lose their temper if other children don't fall into line with their demands. When parents intervene to set reasonable limits, the overly demanding child quickly becomes agitated and angry.

[2] This exaggerated *sense of entitlement* may spring from an early experience of being wounded – an experience that destroys an earlier sense of security and arouses feelings that the child cannot cope with. One trigger might be the birth of a younger brother or sister, leaving the older child feeling neglected or abandoned. Other potentially wounding experiences include a mother's return to work, moving to a new town, parents' rows or the child being left for long periods of time in day care. Each of these could initiate a sense of loss accompanied by an emotional arousal that the child can't handle.

[3] The type of child in question is one with a predisposition to react aggressively when it does not receive what it has come to expect. When the child's expectations are not met, an initial sense of hurt is immediately replaced by a feeling of anger and the child has a *tantrum*.

[4] Child therapists have a saying: *Trust the wisdom of the child*. Children have temper tantrums for a reason. The angry behaviour sends out a signal that the child needs something different from what it is being given. However, it is important not to *take the behaviour at face value*. The child may be screaming to be bought a new toy, but these explicit demands may only be the beginning of the story – in other words, they may conceal as much as they reveal. What the child might really need is neither the toy nor getting his own way, but reassurance. The child may have the deeper and more urgent need to be reassured that it still has the parents' unconditional love.

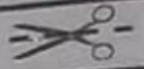
TEXT TWO

[1] India has slowly and *steadily* been growing as a modern state. However, we are still far from being a country that our forefathers visualized. We admire better hygiene and better traffic discipline abroad, but would breach the same back home at the first instance. We condemn our system for churning out unemployed youths, but we don't like working hard to acquire knowledge. There have rather been numerous instances where students have demanded their right to cheat in an examination. It is the same discards that later become a burden as they fail to acquire a skill for employment prospects. Rights are forcefully demanded, but duties are detested.

[2] As citizens of a functioning democracy, we like populist policies and government bounties. Free electricity, free Wi-Fi, free water, free books, free housing, free transport, free health facilities and free education are some of the things we always desire the state to be providing its citizens with and we take them for granted. One does not mind as long as they are provided to the deserving sections of society, but the problem starts when undeserving segments try to corner these benefits through *devious* means. The benefits that are provided by the government are often not used in a responsible manner. Water and electricity are wasted and public utilities vandalized. It is this want of *deference* for public resources that come back to haunt us through poor infrastructures as symptomatic of a backward country.

[3] We want the State to be prompt and efficient in its service delivery but we seldom reciprocate. We forget that it is the people who make the country and not the other way round. We resent *nepotism* in government service delivery, but would not mind peddling influence to seek undue favours.

[4] The proposed plans to develop smart cities would prove *stillborn* if we don't have smart citizens who would be willing to make expected sacrifices for a dignified living. We under-report our income and consequently underpay our taxes, but we resent it when the government complains of a resource crunch to provide for the basic amenities. Digging the road for a private purpose, piling building materials, tapping water sources or electricity are a common sight in this country, but the same people would complain of congested roads, contaminated water or load-shedding without realizing that it is their selfish actions which are affecting the qualities of many of these services.

[5] Observers feel that notwithstanding a huge number of laws and rules, the corresponding enforcement continues to be problematic. While you pay a hefty \$1000 fine for *littering* in a developed country or for a traffic violation, you can get away without any penalty in India through various 'desi jugad' (influence-peddling). Sometimes, the systemic imperfections also hamstring the functioning of the rule of law in this country as the law-abiding citizens do not always get their rightful dues. Today, hundreds of thousands of applications for a fire security certificate or a building plan are allegedly pending in different government offices for years, unless you decide to pass on the speed money to those in *the gravy train*.

[6] Many services in the government today are rightly being outsourced for the inability to deliver in a timely, transparent and efficient manner. Similarly, many other critical services with substantive time and cost overruns, such as passing a building plan or sanctioning a statutory license, should also be outsourced. Information technology needs to be suitably harnessed for most of these services as already being done for various types of government services. E-governance is definitely the way to the future.

[7] As a country, we shall continue to *grovel* in the dust till the citizens understand and appreciate their responsibilities. One only hopes that we shall soon wake up by acting as responsible citizens of a great nation.

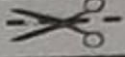
