[1] Ilham Benami had the dream of becoming a fashion designer from her childhood. "Long before I could even go to school, I would watch the tailor next to our door. I would tell myself that one day I would love to design and make kaftans like him or even outperform him", says Ilham.

[2] Being the only daughter of her family, Ilham was not allowed to study abroad, but she was permitted to go after her dream and take a private course in a fashion school in the capital, Rabat. After Ilham graduated, she started to make kaftans for her family and very close people in a room in their home in Salé. But soon she was catering for more than just her family, and as the business expanded she moved to a different location in Salé. "It grew through word of mouth, more and more people wanted kaftans from me," she says.

[3] Now aged 33, she has at least 10 women working for her and the kaftans sell for an average of €300 each. Prices can reach thousands of euros depending on the quality of the material and the time spent on making it.

[4] The kaftan industry is rooted in Moroccan tradition. It is a dress for women that dates back to at least the 16th Century. With modern designs, Ilham makes kaftans that mix Moroccan and European influences. They are part of the booming Moroccan textile sector, which accounts for 15% of the country's exports.



[5] Now that kaftans are moving from the domestic into the international market, their success is encouraging more women into the workforce. It is a good way to earn a respectable income, given the fact that a third of women in the country are unemployed. "Financial autonomy has enhanced women's independence these days, it's a lot easier compared with when I was growing up," says Ilham. "I wanted to work, and fashion has always been a passion of mine, so I was still going to follow my passion no matter what my circumstances were."

[6] The Moroccan kaftans have been modeled in Africa Fashion Week in New York and are exported and sold in different countries. Today, the kaftan designs have a more Western look with a Moroccan touch, which explains why they are becoming more successful internationally. Ilham's story shows that Moroccan women can realize their dreams and be financially independent.
